There is a desperate need for leadership in the 21st century.


Our challenging and Christ-centered academic environment combines a deeper exploration of faith and learning where students are encouraged to take their leadership to the next level. An interdisciplinary approach allows scholars to pursue a unique combination of theory and practical experience in leadership development. The degree program is designed to produce leaders with the practical knowledge, training, and unique skills necessary to develop other leaders.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

The Doctor of Education in Educational Leadership is a **60-hour accelerated doctoral program** that allows students to complete the degree while continuing to live in their current location.

The degree consists of:

- 15 hours Core studies in educational leadership
- 18 hours Selected concentration (six options)
- 12 hours Research studies
- 15 hours Dissertation research and writing

COHORT STRUCTURE

Students progress through the online courses and research as a cohort, completing the program in 34 months. Cohort programs begin in August of each year, with classes offered each spring, summer, and fall.

Students enroll in 1-2 classes of three (3) credit hours each 8-week term. The online program design provides significant learning experiences through the online component of each class.

The dissertation process is interwoven throughout the class structure, allowing students to complete the entire program in less than three years. **8** week class available
